ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

You will receive an email confirming receipt of your abstract within one business day.

ABSTRACT ACCEPTANCE NOTIFICATION

We will confirm via email whether your abstract has been accepted for inclusion in the conference or not. If your abstract has been accepted, we will also provide you with the details regarding submission of your draft paper and documents we require when you submit your paper.

DRAFT PAPER SUBMISSION

Before preparing your draft paper for submission, we ask you to visit the Author's Portal on the ACG Surface Mining website and download the documents listed on page 1 of this pack.

To submit a draft paper for this conference, please visit the Paper Submission page on the ACG Surface Mining website and complete the online form. Please note this information pack will be updated with the link to this form at a later date.

REVIEWER FEEDBACK

All papers submitted for ACG events undergo a single-blind peer review process. All reviewer comments, tracked changes, and feedback will be incorporated into your draft paper, together with ACG desktop publishing changes.

We will send this reviewed version for you to address the comments in your paper. You must address and make the changes. If you do not make the changes, please provide an explanation. In some cases, your paper will be returned to the reviewer/s for confirmation changes have been appropriately made.

We will also provide you with the details regarding final paper submission.

SPEAKER REGISTRATION

Please note we will not undertake any desktop publishing or proofreading work on your final paper until you have registered as a speaker.

If you register and subsequently withdraw your paper from the conference, the ACG will withhold an editorial fee of AUD400.

FINAL PAPER SUBMISSION

To submit your final paper, please do so via email or WeTransfer (www.wetransfer.com), depending on the size of the document. We will review the paper to ensure reviewer comments have been addressed and will return the paper to you if further work is required.

Once the paper is ready to finalise, we will undertake a full edit and proofread of your paper. Following this, we will send a PDF version of your final paper to you for review. This is to ensure no figures or details have moved during conversion from Word to PDF.

REMOTE PRESENTER REHEARSAL

If you are presenting remotely, we recommend that you schedule a time with the ACG Audiovisual team to practice using the online platform. You will be emailed approximately one month before the event to arrange a date and time for the rehearsal.

PRESENTATION SUBMISSION

If you are **presenting in person**, we require your presentation PowerPoint slides as these will be used at the time of your presentation. If you are **presenting remotely**, we require a pre-recorded presentation as this will be used in the event there are technical issues on the day of your presentation or if, for whatever reason, you are unable to deliver your presentation live.

Please forward your slides or presentation via WeTransfer (if too large to submit via email).

PUBLICATION PERMISSION AGREEMENT

In order to publish your paper and deliver your presentation, we require you to complete, sign, and submit the publication permission agreement. Your paper will be published in the Proceedings of the Second International Slope Stability in Mining Conference, as well as on the ACG Online Repository of Conference Proceedings:

All presentations will be recorded and will include any questions asked and answers provided.

You will retain copyright of your work as we only ask for a non-exclusive licence.

ACG ONLINE REPOSITORY OF CONFERENCE PROCEEDINGS

The final papers will go live on the ACG Online Repository of Conference Proceedings (Online Repository) on 18 October 2021.

We encourage you to provide us with your LinkedIn, ResearchGate, and ORCID profiles so that these can be linked to your profile on the Online Repository. This will allow you to easily share your papers on these platforms.

The Online Repository has papers from almost 50 conferences and includes 6 previous open pit mining events hosted by the ACG.

Of the 6 open pit mining conferences and 311 open pit papers available on the Online Repository, there have been:

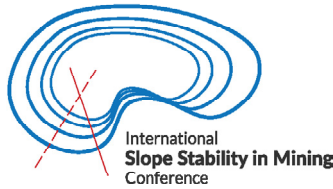
- 78,829 total paper downloads
